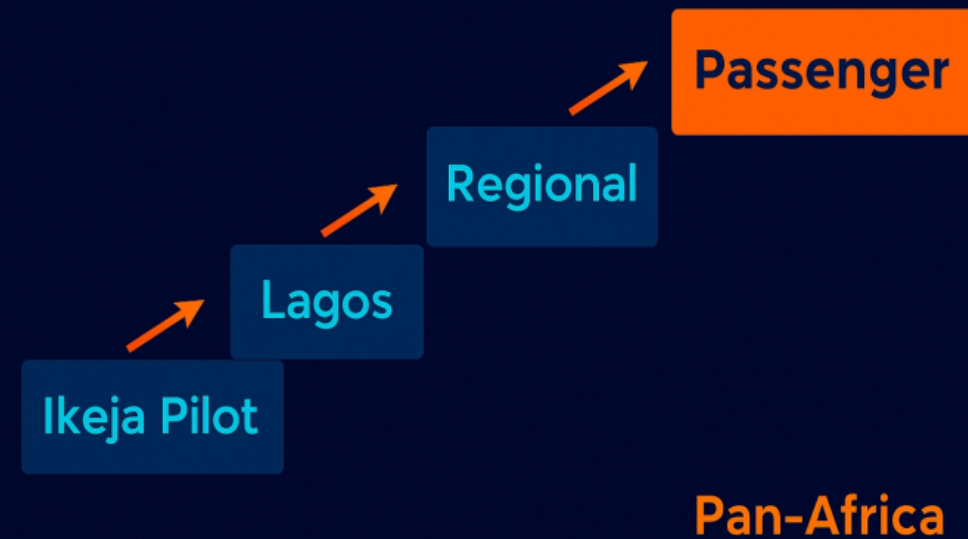

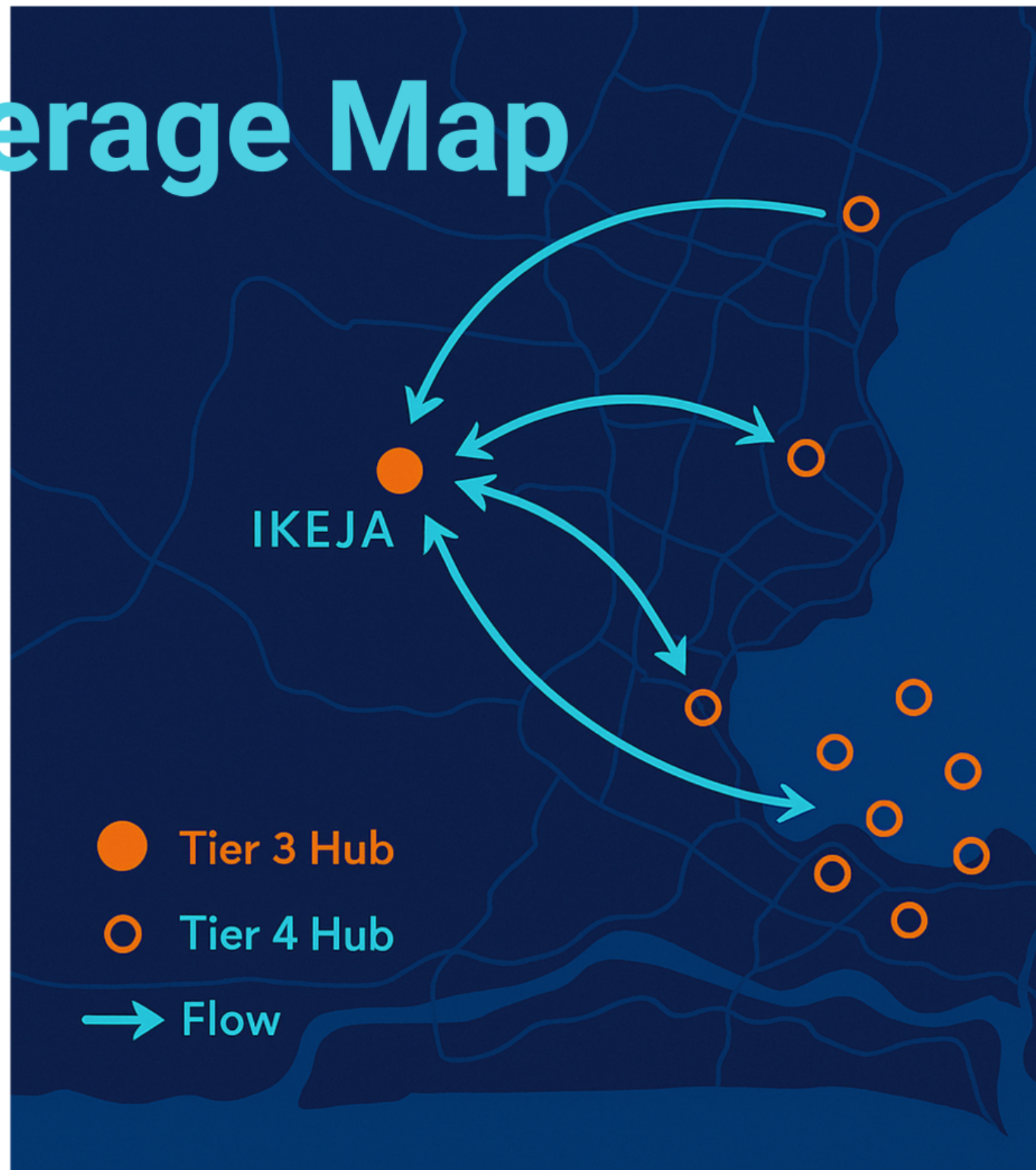


Pilot Coverage Map

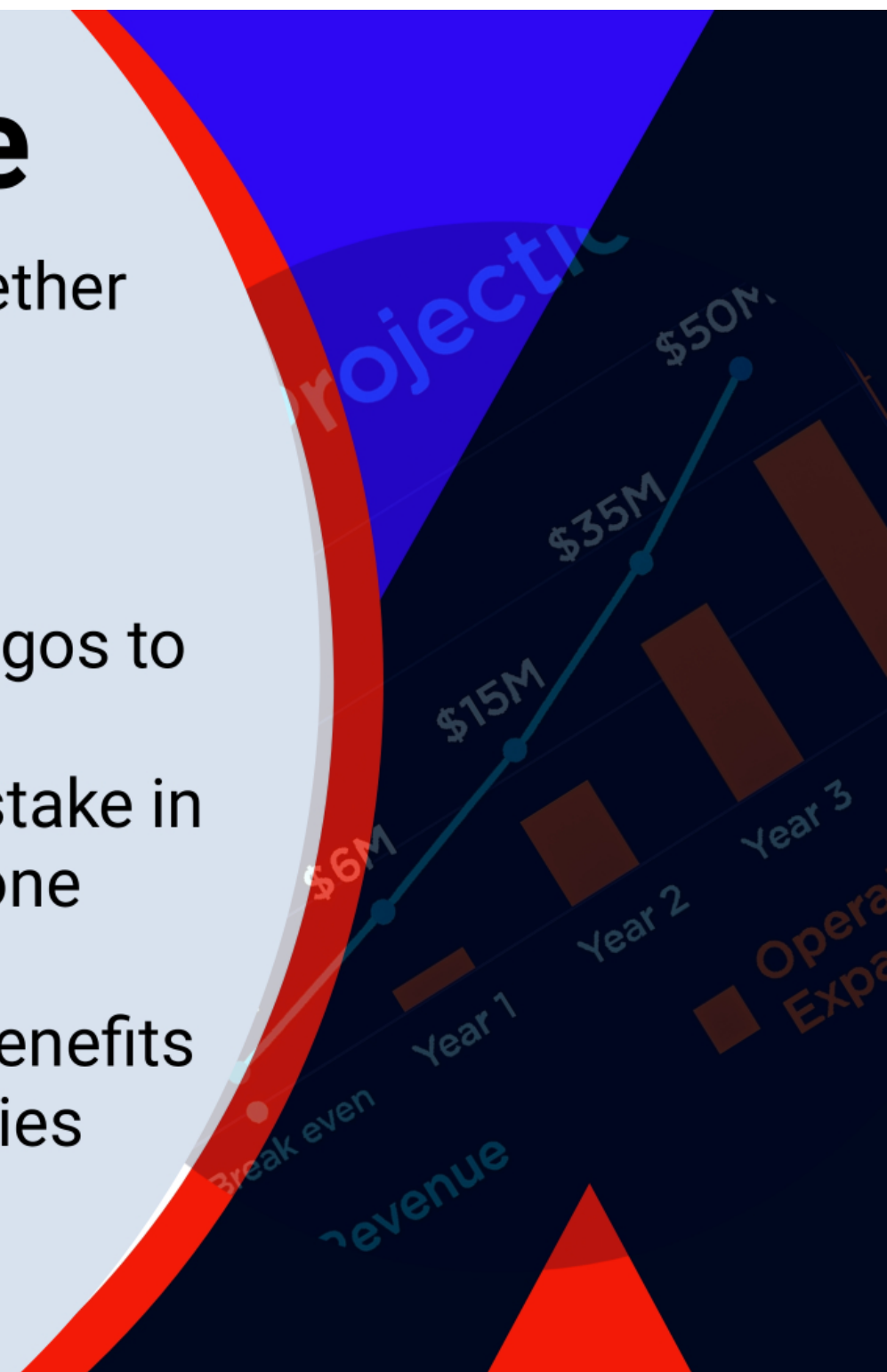
